PARENT TO DO LIST

- 1. Get dates set up with the church. Contact Mr. Banks and he will coordinate with the church. The church sanctuary will be used for the ceremony and the reception will be held at the Scout House.
 - There is no cost to use the sanctuary but the Troop asks that you make a donation to the church.
 - Sunday ceremonies are the best but are not written in stone.
 - Eagle Ceremonies must start at 2pm and conclude no later than 5pm.
 - The Eagle ceremony will be in the sanctuary. The reception will be in the Scout House.
 - Meet the Scoutmaster at 11:15 on the Sunday of your son's Court of Honor at the Scout House. (Please note, no earlier than 11:15 by request of the church).
- 2. Get all of your pictures together for your son's Trail to Eagle disk.
 - Work with Mr. Munro to make sure the video is compatible with the system used at the church. (Please see pages 11)
- 3. Order your son's Eagle commemorative flag case if desired (Please see page 8) as soon as possible.
- 4. At least 3 weeks before the ceremony, contact the photographer (Please see Page 6).
- 5. At least 3 weeks before the ceremony, contact the Troop 19 IT Director (Mr. Munro, Please see page 12).
- 6. At least 3 weeks before the ceremony, contact Eagle Angels for help with serving during the reception (Please see page 7).
- 7. At least 3 weeks before the ceremony, order your son's cake for the reception (Please see page 9).
- 8. Develop Court of Honor Program.
 - See example at the beginning of this book and page 12.
 - Follow order exactly to be compatible with the technical layout.
 - Email proof to the Scoutmaster at least 1 week prior to your son's Court of Honor.
- 9. Send off the National Eagle Scout Association (NESA) application as soon as possible (can take 6-8 weeks).
- 10. Send in the Lake Norman Citizen Eagle write-up 3 weeks before the ceremony (see page 10).
- 11. 3 weeks before the ceremony, set-up Troop invite on the Facebook group page.
- 12. Mentor Pins 1 pin comes in your presentation kit; if you desire to give more, you must pick them up from the Scout Shop.
 - Mentor pins cans go to anyone your Scout feels mentored him during his time in Scouting and on his Trail to Eagle.

- 13. Your son's brag table this should be a culmination of your son's Scouting history, Cubs through present and should include school, church, and all other activities. These items will be on display on center tables during your son's Eagle Court of Honor reception.
 - One 6-foot long rectangle table will be for all items your son receives during the Court of Honor
- 14. Reception—The menu is of the family's choosing but we ask that you remember that this will be an outdoor setting with no tables to sit down at during the reception. There are serving utensils at the Scout House.
 - Suggested menu items include:
 - i. Finger foods
 - ii. Cake
 - iii. Bottled Drinks (you will need to provide cooler and ice)
 - The troop has all the table for your food and drink items.
 - Please bring folding or camp chairs if desired as there are none available for outside
 - Be Prepared to move inside if inclement weather (space will be limited).
- 15. Don't forget your Mother's Ribbon (to be worn over your heart).

- Colors Contact Assistant Senior Patrol Leader of Honor Guard, he will then contact his team.
- Invocation Troop Chaplain or Minister
- Candle Lighting Ceremony Scouts of your son's choice.
- Voice of the Eagle Assistant Scoutmaster of your son's choosing.
- NESA Induction Eagle candidate must contact prior Eagle or get the neckerchief and slide to have another previous Eagle present to him. (See picture of neckerchief and slide on next page).
- Eagle Escort—This will be an Eagle of the Troop. You will need to contact him.
- Eagle Project Review Assistant Scoutmaster of your son's choosing or the benefactor.
- Eagle Commendations Assistant Scoutmaster of your son's choosing
 - Book has already been completed by the Scoutmaster.
- Good Citizenship Award The Scoutmaster will have already scheduled with USMC and USN.
- Flag Presentation Assistant Scoutmaster of your son's choosing.
 - Flag has already been ordered for your son.
- Closing Prayer Same as Invocation.





Troop 19 Tech Information

General Information

Troop 19 is privileged to have an AV Tech Team. This team consists of adult members that are trained to operate the sound equipment at Huntersville Presbyterian Church. Since all Troop 19 Eagle Court of Honor's are conducted in the church sanctuary, this team MUST be used. Below is some vital information regarding your son's Eagle Ceremony and things that both you and your son need to do.

As soon as you have a date set with the church office, please contact the Troop AV Coordinator and let him know the date and time of the ceremony. With our limited pool of trained technicians, this advance notice is greatly appreciated in order to confirm scheduling.

Important Items Needed for the Ceremony

- 1. Coordinate all technical logistics with the Troop AV Coordinator and inform him of any needs you might have.
- 2. Locate all of your Troop Year End CDs that you have for all the years your son has been in the troop.
 - If you are missing discs from certain years, look first on the Troop Shutterfly for pictures. If they are not there, then contact Matt Jones.

- 3. Gather all the pictures you want to use for the My Eagle Trail and pick out 2-3 songs to go along with it. Use your program of choice (ex: iMovie, Windows Movie Maker, Filmora, etc.) to create a video of the slide show.
 - The AV System at the church can support MP4 and MOV files, use the H.264 codec to reduce file size.
 - Creating your video in a 16:9 format with a HD resolution of 720p or 1080p is suggested for ideal viewing at home (The church AV system is not true HD, but will support these settings).
- 4. Gather the photos for your son's Eagle Service project. You can either create a video using the settings above, or bring the individual photos as JPGs—adding numbers to the file names for proper ordering.
 - The church does not support PowerPoint or Keynote presentations; you must provide either a video file or separate image files.
- 5. Your son must contact the Troop AV coordinator at least 3 weeks prior to his Court of Honor to confirm contact info for his assigned AV teach.
